## OTHER NOTES:

Half-ton bin fermentation, gently punch-downs using only our hands, and a long, cool maceration results in a rich and extracted Pinot Noir. The wine is aged in 35% new French oak barrels for 15 months before it is hand-bottled.

## TASTING NOTES:

Rich new oak notes with bright cherry, white pepper and cloves in the nose. Cranberry, pomegranate and red raspberry flavors accented by the classic "Russian River" spice. Cream background ends with a lengthy finish.
